## Sacramental Journey: One step closer to God

The sacraments of Christian initiation- Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist- lay the foundation of every Christian life... The faithful are born anew by Baptism, strengthened by the sacrament of Confirmation, and receive in the Eucharist the food of eternal life' (CCC 1212).

We have often heard about the saying "it's about the journey and not the destination". But with the hundreds of journeys that we travel as we grow on our spiritual life, how can you make that journey to the Sacraments count and be memorable for children who wish to get closer to God?

The Sacramental Team of Infant Jesus, Morley, follows a program that aims for the journey of every child, towards the Sacraments of Eucharist, Confirmation, and Reconciliation to be a time to cherish and remember for the rest of their life.

At the beginning of each Sacrament Program, sacramental families and children at Infant Jesus Parish Morley, are encouraged to attend an enrolment Mass, followed by the commitment Mass. These moments are very special, as families are able to celebrate at Mass together where they are also welcomed and prayed for by the parish community.

Parents play an active and important role in their children's sacramental journey. The sacramental team supports the parents by organising Parents Information Meetings where they can grow in faith and in understanding of the meaning and implication of the Sacrament which their child is receiving. The Parents and Child Workshop is also held to give parents and children a chance to interact with each other. This workshop encourages faith sharing between parents and their children, and it relates the Sacrament to the daily life of the family.
