Tan was formally inducted into this ministry at the Cathedral by Bishop Don Sproxton two weeks ago, after some formal training and is now being trained on our Altar by our senior acolytes. I thank and congratulate Tan for his willingness to give himself to God and to his parish family in this way. —Fr. Sunny

In 2011, the Holy Father announced a Year of Faith for the universal church. The Year of Faith commenced on October 11, 2012 and will continue through to the Feast of Christ the King, in November, 2013.

Why did the year start on a Thursday, 11 October? This is an important date for the church; the 50th anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council. This Council brought about significant change and renewal to the worldwide church. It is hoped that the Year of Faith will help us continue that renewal.

What is the Year of Faith for? Pope Benedict, in his letter on the Year of Faith, expresses his hope that this will be an opportunity to deepen our understanding of our faith, the faith which we all profess every time we come to Mass. This will necessarily involve us deepening our knowledge of Jesus and understanding his love for us. Only when we truly understand the treasure we have in our faith will we be truly ready to share that faith with others.

I thought we already have the Year of Grace? We do! The Year of Grace is an initiative of the Australian Bishops and it is the perfect way to prepare for and enter into the Year of Faith. In asking God to grant us the grace to "start afresh from Christ" we begin the Year of Faith already open to His prompting us to find new ways to come face to face with Jesus and to have our faith in him renewed. The Year of Grace continues to do its work in us until Pentecost 2013.

So what now? Begin! In prayer, ask God to give us all the grace to understand our faith more deeply. Read the Holy Father's letter— copies are on the bulletin stand in the foyer. 


