- To see the Year of Faith as a summons to an authentic conversion to the Lord and a time of purification for the Church.
- To intensify the *celebration* of the faith in the liturgy, especially the Eucharist.

Well, you could start with *Lumen Gentium (Light of the Nations)* and *Dei Verbum (Word of God)*.
