St Mary's Cathedral, Perth Holy Trinity Abbey, New Norcia Our Lady of the Mission, Whitfords Schoenstatt Shrine, Mt Richon St Patrick's Basilica, Fremantle St Mary's Kalgoorlie Carmelite Monastery, Nedlands Redemptorist Monastry, North Perth

Pope Francis has asked that each pilgrimage be linked first and foremost, to the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the celebration of the Holy Eucharist with a reflection on mercy. "It will be necessary to

accompany Eucharist at these places of pilgrimage with the profession of faith and with prayer for me and for the intentions that I bear in my heart for the good of the Church and of the entire world" - **Pope Francis**
