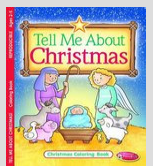
COMMUNION TO THE HOUSEBOUND AND ELDERLY

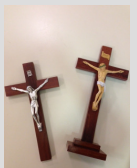


The Wood of the Cross

RCIA NEWS

Currently we have five inquirers for reception into the Catholic faith through the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. In two week's time, some of these enquirers, if not all, will take part in the Rite of Acceptance at one of our weekend Masses. Once they complete this Rite, they will become Catechumens and begin to prepare for their baptism next Easter. They are officially welcomed by the Church as disciples, members (albeit not yet full members) of the household of faith.

The text calls this rite "the first consecration by the Church" of those seeking Christian initiation. They are literally marked with the cross of Christ as God's own. Consequently, the gathered community and its spirit of welcome, *as well as* the inquirers and their promise of discipleship, are essential to this rite.

As well as our inquirers, we have four young people who are preparing for the Sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation and who will also receive these Sacraments at the East Vigil service.

Please keep all these people in your prayers as their journeys continue.
