### **PARISH SACRAMENTAL PROGRAMME 2013**

This programme is for those parents who wish their children to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation. A requirement of the programme is that the child receive a minimum of 2 years religious education, either in a Catholic school or in a parish religious education programme.

The first Sacrament to be celebrated in our parish will be First Communion. The enrolment Masses for this Sacrament will be on the Weekend of 9 & 10 of March. Parents may bring their children to either the 6.30pm vigil Mass on the Saturday night, or the 9.30am or 6pm Mass on the Sunday.

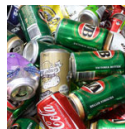

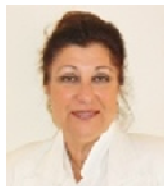
