2nd Sunday of Easter Divine Mercy Sunday The second Sunday of Easter was designated by the Holy

Father 'Divine Mercy Sunday' in 2002, when he entrusted the entire world to the Father's divine and unfailing mercy. The words "mercy" and "merciful" appear around 150 times in Scripture. *Hesed*, or tender mercy, is God's greatest characteristic in the Old Testament. For example, Moses was told that the Lord is "merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness" (Ex 34:6). King David, who knew something about sin and justice, wrote, "Have mercy on me, O God, according to thy steadfast love; according to thy abundant mercy blot out my transgressions" (Ps 51:3). This mercy is boundless and undeserved compassion; in the New Testament it is called *agape*, which is pure love.—*Carl Olsen, OSV Newsweekly*
