COVID-19 Phase 3 of W.A. Roadmap in Infant Jesus Parish

We commit Infant Jesus Parish to support and comply with all government directives and associated public health advice in our response to this emergency. In accordance with Phase 3 of the W.A. Roadmap our Parish Church will be open at normal times. I want to thank all those volunteers who have enabled us to open the church for mass this past week and will enable us to remain open during Phase 3.

Monday to Friday masses: 7.00am and 9.00am

Saturdays and Public Holidays: 8.30am

Sunday masses: 6.00pm (Saturday), 7.30am, 9.30am and 11.30am (Italian) and 6.00pm.

Sacrament of Reconciliation: Saturday 10- 11am and 5.00 – 5.30pm.

Up to one hundred (100) people may be present in the church at any one time. There needs to be two square metres of floor space per person and a physical distance of 1.5 metres from persons of other households. There is no need to book for weekday mass but bookings are required to ensure a place for Sunday masses. Priority will be given to those who have booked but if space is available others will also be admitted until the limit of 100 people is reached.

Please only sit in the marked places. Attendance records are kept with name, contact details and times of arrival and departure. The COVID Safety Plan is visible in the entry to the church.

Limit of 100 people per Mass—In line with WA Government COVID-19 Regulation



If we want our Masses to continue...

In order to re-open our church and parish centre, the parish was required to sign an agreement with the WA government to implement the mandatory Covid-19 guidelines. This has involved a lot of extra work for our parish staff and means that we are required to guarantee a continual Covid-19 cleaning regime and provide attendees at the church doors whenever the church is open, to ensure contact details are collected for everyone who comes into the church.



Our parish staff are employed part-time and usually work many extra hours. The Covid-19 guidelines implementation has greatly increased the hours the staff have had to work to ensure our compliance. This includes the staff taking turns to clean and disinfect the toilets and atrium areas regularly during office hours

If we want the church and parish centre to remain open, we must have more help to fill cleaning and marshalling rosters. This situation will continue until the regulations are no longer required. We cannot expect the staff to attend to all of this 7 days a week.

Both the church and the toilets need Covid19 cleaning after each Mass. Our Maintenance Manager, Andrew, has devised a very quick and simple method to disinfect the toilets that requires no hands on contact with any surfaces. All cleaning equipment and instruction will be provided.

We need many people to put their hands up so that we can roster people on at least fortnightly, if not monthly, so that no one person has to do too much.

OUR PARISH—COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

Phase 3 of Western Australia's COVID-19 Roadmap

We are committed to do all that we can to stop the spread of the COVID-19 virus. And so, we comply with all the safety requirements of the Government of Western Australia's Phase 3 COVID-19 roadmap.

- A maximum of one hundred (100) people are allowed within the church or parish centre at any one time.
- There is a strict limit of one person per two-square metres, with a physical distance of 1.5 metres between people.
- Records with names and contact details and times of entry and exit are maintained of persons entering the church or parish centre.
- Social distancing must be observed in waiting areas.
- For hygiene purposes hand sanitiser is to be used before entering either building.
- We commit to routine cleaning and sanitisation of frequently used surfaces including pews, seats, kneelers, doorknobs, and toilets.

Directional signage in the Church and directions given by our staff and volunteers are to be followed.

Staff and volunteers are to be trained to understand and apply these guidelines as well as how to respond to a COVID-19.


