Prophets disturb our comfort and our conventions; they will stand for justice and goodness and practise what they preach; are mocked and dismissed by those who have power, wealth and entitlement and who defend the status quo in the name of tradition. Who do we welcome and who do we find it difficult to welcome into our parish community? Today's gospel speaks to a change in us that recognises and responds to the radical call of Christ to welcome him in those who are different from us.
