

Dear brothers and sisters,

The parable in today's Gospel (Matt 21:28-32) can be understood on various levels. In Jesus' context it probably served to defend his practice of celebrating God's mercy with those considered outcasts and sinners. Jesus acted inclusively rather than exclusively. At a deeper level, the parable tells us that God does not rush angrily to judgement but waits patiently for the final outcome in people's lives. God can put up with an initial 'No' and a lot of 'No's' on the way to a final and lasting 'Yes'. On the other hand, the sinless, religious and observant may never have had to plumb the depth of God's mercy to know God as God really is. Conversion at depth gives the capacity to say 'Yes' with an abundance of freedom that overflows into a pattern of life truly reflective of God's grace. A judgmental attitude towards others likely indicates a lack of true conversion and real knowledge of God. What matters is the conformity of the human heart to the heart of God. It is not repeating the right words or practices that bring us to life with God, it is gratefully saying yes to God's free gift of love.

The Second Reading (Philippians 2:1-11) contains one of the treasures of the New Testament: the very early 'Christ-Hymn' that Paul quotes in order to remind the community in Philippi that the heart of good community relations is a sharing of the 'mind' (disposition) of Christ. All his life Christ displayed self-emptying love, something that issued forth in 'obedience unto death', even to the cross. This is what being 'in a divine state', being 'equal to God', means. Christian community life ought to be energised by the overflow of divine love that wells up within us through our existence 'in Christ'.

We are called then to 'put on the mind of Christ' by personal prayer and meditation on Scripture; to live well; and to be actively engaged in offering together the best possible worship at our Sunday masses with attentive listening to the readings, good homilies, and vibrant music in an attractive atmosphere that is open and welcoming to all who come to our parish.—*Blessings, Greg*
