Dear Parishioners,

This Tuesday, 16th July, is a very special day for the Carmelite communities around the world, the Feast of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. Most Catholics would recognize Our Lady of Mt. Carmel by the brown scapular she is depicted as holding. Not so many Catholics, today, know the story of this scapular which was purported to have been given to St. Simon Stock by the Blessed Virgin in a vision, with the promise that all who died wearing this form of dress would be saved.

Thus today, the Carmelite Order still dress in the brown robes, with the long piece of material (the scapular) at the front. For many centuries, the brown scapular became a popular sacramental amongst the laity and many of us would remember wearing it under our clothing (or perhaps, still do) as a protection.

The Carmelite Order, which takes its name from Mt. Carmel in Israel, uses the name Our Lady of Mt. Carmel as a mark of love and respect. It is just one of the many honorary titles given to our Blessed Mother and like her other titles, Our Lady of Lourdes, Our Lady of Fatima, and so on, each name we use is a reminder to us of Mary's repeated message to the world; to pray constantly and never stop seeking her Son; that to live in holiness and to follow Christ is the only way to find peace and safety. Always, she is pointing not to herself, but to Jesus. On this great Feast, let us join together in prayer and pray for our world, that it may turn again to Christ and that we may all learn to love God and love each other.

Here at Morley, we will celebrate the Feast at our usual morning Masses, and of course we are holding a "Party for Mary", for the children to enjoy the day as well.
