### PLANNED GIVING CAMPAIGN UPDATE

The renewal campaign for the Planned Giving Programme for the next three years is now complete. The situation is as follows: we have in excess of 450 contributors to the programme, an increase of about 20. The bulk of these are those who have agreed to contribute regularly through the weekly envelopes. The number of people using the direct debit facility has increased slightly, while we now have a few contributors who will make direct transfers from their bank to the Parish.

The promised amount for the year is \$234,344 with a weekly total of \$4506, at an average of just over \$10 per contributor. However, as our records show, we do not receive the full amount promised each year. The figures for the last three years show;-

It is hoped that in the coming year we will receive an amount closer to that which was pledged.

The total for the second collection is increased by the loose cash each week. This figure cannot be budgeted for, however!

It is the loose collection which brings our weekly total to a figure which allows the Parish to meet its commitments.

The campaign recently completed involved a great number of people from our parish. I would like to sincerely thank all who assisted. The planned giving committee had an inclusion of new members, who with the stalwarts of the past worked very well and augers well for the future. The parish office staff (Angela and Darren) have to be singled out for the excellent work they provided in updating records and in managing the very important tasks of rolling over the data in time for the new year's activities.

Others who are vital to the successful running of the planned giving through the year must also be acknowledged for their consistent help. These include the collectors at mass, those who count the cash each week and arrange the banking, the data entry people who record the week's activity and Brother James who keeps a watchful eye over it all. These tasks are not high profile jobs but are essential to the efficient running of the programme and deserve our recognition and thanks.

Finally, to all who have supported the second collection, not only this last year but for the last several decades we extend our grateful thanks. It is through this continued support that we have been able to provide the facilities which we enjoy here at Morley.
