

Dear brothers and sisters,

I used to think that the Feast of Christ the King must have come from a time when kings and queens were thick upon the ground. But, no, it was instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925. Now that was a time when Mussolini was ruling Italy and Stalin the Soviet Union and Hitler was making his presence felt. Pius was telling these dictators was that for all their grandiose ambitions and imperial pretensions their kingdoms would not last. But Christ's reign was both universal and eternal.

Our First Reading (Dn 7:13-14) is fascinating. It comes after Daniel gives us a number of visions of people eating monsters who are symbols of the different historical Empires that had come and gone. Against this he intuits a new leader, the "Son of Man" one with a human heart- who compassionately heals and sets people free. His reign will last forever. For Christian readers of Daniel the Son of man is Jesus, our Lord.

Our Gospel (Jn 18:33-37) underlines that the Son of Man is not a king like those of the powers that were in his time. These were insecure men and that meant they resorted to violence, intimidation the cult of personality to prop up their reigns. The kingdom of God that Jesus speaks of is 'not a kingdom of this world' so there is no violence or domination. Jesus come as a witness to the truth of the love of God, he comes to set us free, and to reconcile and unite us. In the words of today's Preface to the Eucharistic Prayer:

O God "you anointed your Only Begotten Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, with the oil of gladness as eternal Priest and King of all creation, so that, by offering himself on the altar of the Cross as a spotless sacrifice to bring us peace, he might accomplish the mysteries of human redemption and, making all created things subject to his rule, he might present to.. (you) an eternal and universal kingdom, a kingdom of truth and life, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love and peace.


