Dear brothers and sisters,

In the First Reading (Is 66:18-21) the prophet foresees salvation reaching beyond Israel to all the nations of the world. We who are baptised in Christ, are heirs of this promise. This theme is continued in the Gospel (Lk 13:22-30) where Jesus observes that 'people from east and west, from north and south will come to take their places at the feast in the Kingdom of God.' But that does not mean we can be complacent, put our feet up and either do nothing or whatever we feel like. Those who think they are 'insiders' need to wake up. They will see many included whom they considered outsiders beyond the pale.

So, Jesus warns us not to miss the opportunity to act compassionately in line with the faith we profess while it is still available. In Luke's Gospel the hospitality of God is ample and generous. In the preaching of Jesus all are invited to the banquet. We can exclude ourselves from the banquet by not being prepared to accept the divine hospitality and to be in the company of those whom God chooses. Conversion of the heart is an ongoing priority as God's ways are not ours. The Gospel challenges the narrowness of our thoughts and the limits of our generosity. To allow this to happen is to go in by 'the narrow gate', the gate that strips us of the 'baggage' of our selfishness.

National Synthesis of Consultation for the Synod on Synodality

Catholics throughout Australia have expressed a strong need for a Church that is missionary and a Eucharistic community that is inclusive, the national synthesis for the global Synod on Synodality has revealed. Material from every diocese was drawn upon as well as hundreds of submissions from groups and individuals. Trudy Dantis who collated the results said, "Through the Synod of Bishops and the Plenary Council, we have been able to capture and listen more deeply to the voices of people within and beyond the Catholic population."
