

## Dear Brothers and Sisters,

There is a sharp social justice focus in the Scriptures today. In today's Gospel we again focus on Luke's teaching on the use and abuse of riches. Greed and grasping lead to a useless way of life that does not see the suffering of others and is unable to respond actively to help those who are poor, disadvantaged, and powerless. In the **First Reading** the splendid Amos (Am 6:1, 2-7) describes how the rich loll about in luxury, feasting every day while caring nothing for the ruin of the sisters and brothers.

The parable that forms the **Gospel**, (Lk 16:19-31) is the only one in which a character is named – the poor man Lazarus. The unnamed rich man is so absorbed in his comfortable life that he simply does not notice the poor beggar lying in desperate need at his gate. The parable turns on the Lucan theme of a great reversal that is to take place cf. Mary's Magnificat (Lk 1:51-53) and the Beatitudes (Lk 6:20-26). The chief point is the reversal of fortune. The rich man after death is in agony while the poor man enjoys life. Living in luxury blinded the rich man to the need of a fellow human being and to wider social responsibility. The opportunity to attend to such obligations will not last for ever. When God acts on behalf of the poor and all is reversed, the rich will find themselves trapped in a painful and unchangeable predicament of their own making. The parable, then is an invitation to conversion.

Today is the Church's 108th **World Day of Migrants and Refugees** with the theme "Building the future with Migrants and Refugees". Pope Francis exhorts us: "If we want to cooperate with our heavenly Father in building the future, let us do so together with our brothers and sisters who are migrants and refugees. Let us build the future today! For the future begins today and it begins with each of us. We cannot leave to future generations the burden of responsibility for decisions that need to be made now, so that God's plan for the world may be realized and his Kingdom of justice, fraternity, and peace may come."

In the past our parish had a lively Refugee Support Group. It did great work with a spirit of relaxed hospitality as strangers were welcomed and helped to feel at home in our country. I would really love to see us to have such a group in our parish at this time.—*Blessings, Greg*

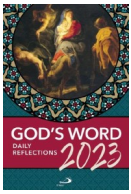
