Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Our loving God builds a bridge between the Holy Trinity and humanity by which "people can draw near to the Father, through Christ, the Word made flesh, in the Holy Spirit and thus become sharers in the divine nature' (Dei Verbum, 2). The Trinity is the abundant source and sustenance of all life. The life-giving mission of the Trinity binds all creatures to God and to one another through their participation in God's own life. So, an authentic response to God will involve life-giving relationships. We usually call this gift of God 'grace' and our response 'faith'. Our life is a journey on which none of us, neither monarchs, popes or priests, are exempt from adversity. Our faith is tested and grows through these experiences.

In the **First Reading** (Hab 1: 2-3, 2:2-4) Habakkuk lived in tumultuous times. He complains in the first part of our reading that his prayers are not heard, for good people suffer and the bad prosper. The reading then moves on to the divine response and the assurance that the vision of a divine intervention will be fulfilled. What is required in the meantime of waiting is faithfulness: "the upright person lives by faithfulness'.

Luke 17 begins with Jesus' injunction to forgiveness no matter how often someone offends you. Today's **Gospel** (Lk 17:5-10) begins with the response of the disciples to the command to forgive: "Increase our faith!' Jesus replies that the little faith they already have is enough to work wonders. Jesus exaggerates to make this point: take the risk of faith so as to clothe yourself with the power of God. It is people of faith who activate God's power in the world.

In the second part of the Gospel Jesus takes an example from the life of slaves in his time. His point is that we should not serve in the hope of gaining payment or reward. Instead he urges us to be conscious, through faith, of the immense benefits we have received from God's grace long before any good work or virtuous action on our part. Our Christian service must primarily be an expression of faith and be motivated by abiding gratitude for all God has done for us.

The picture from today's three disparate readings, including Paul's advice in the **Second Reading** (2 Tim 1:6-8, 13-14), is that of a God in whose faithfulness and superabundant generosity we can trust and so bear fruit in lifegiving relationship marked by trust, faithfulness and love.


A group of parishioners tidy the church weekly. Those who volunteer: care for the interior of the church, vacuum the carpet, do light cleaning, clean the glass windows.
