Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The connection between the **First Reading** (2 Kgs 5:14-17) and the **Gospel** (Lk 17:11-19) is clear. Both depict a person who has been cured from a repellent skin complaint returning to acknowledge and give thanks to God. It is actually worth reading the full account of Naaman's healing 2Kgs5: 1-17. The Syrian general Naaman learns that Israel's God is the only God of the whole earth and that no payment, either to God or God's prophet, is required or accepted. God gives favours with absolute freedom and generosity. The one thing necessary is a grateful heart. On Jesus' journey to Jerusalem, ten persons afflicted with a skin complaint cry out to Jesus for mercy while keeping their distance as the Law obliged them. All ten are made clean when following Jesus' instructions they go and show themselves to the priest. For nine of them that is where the matter ends. But the tenth, another 'good Samaritan', returns loudly praising God. The behaviour of the despised foreigner has shown up those in the Jewish world of the time.

The Samaritan is only one who hears these words of Jesus: 'your faith has brought you salvation.' In Luke's Gospel 'salvation' involves the whole person not just physical healing or rescue, above all it means coming to know God as the God who loves, understands and saves. Here is someone, excluded and rejected by reason of his illness and his ethnic/religious background, who is more open to really know Israel's God. He thereby experiences holistic physical and spiritual healing. The episode is not just about the salvation of an afflicted person. It is a summons for all of us to conversion.

Self-pity undermines the joy of life. The Lord who loves us gives us an integral healing of mind, body and spirit if we are open to taking his word and his love to heart. The appropriate response to this gift is gratitude. The word eucharist means to give thanks for good gifts from God. Catholics are eucharistic people when in celebrating the Eucharist and in all life we give thanks to God and are always grateful.
