Dear brothers and sisters,

Today we end the yearly liturgical cycle with the feast of Christ the King. This was inaugurated in 1925 by Pope Pius XI as a reminder that though world powers may fail, the reign of Christ has been established with its lasting peace and justice. While the world uses power to dominate and glories in luxury and pomp, Jesus displays the power of God's reign on the Cross. The values of this world, which lead to the horrors of Ukraine, Burma and many other places need to be turned upside down for true peace to be established.

Wars begin with greed and selfishness, whether on a world scale or the wars within the family home. Peace begins where there is generosity, forgiveness and concern about others. This is the 'kingdom' that Jesus came to offer and the power that we celebrate in today's feast. Luke's Gospel comes to an end with the image of the crucified Saviour offering life in God's gracious love to a dying criminal. The heavens are opened for those who desire to live in God.

The beautiful hymn from Colossians offers an understanding of the universe in the light of Christian faith. The life, death and resurrection of Jesus have a central place not only within human history but also in the cosmos. Today Christ is proclaimed the Universal King. May the Lord touch our hearts and move us to share his life, joy and peace.

PLENARY COUNCIL

The Australian Catholic Bishops have formally approved the acts and decrees of the Fifth Plenary Council which will now be sent to the Apostolic See (Rome) for review. The documents, which comprise five volumes across hundreds of pages, were received at the Bishops Conference's plenary meeting last week. As the acts and decrees were received, the bishops sang the Te Deum, acknowledging the solemnity of the moment in the life of the Church in Australia. "It was quite a poignant moment as we sensed – once again – the significance of the Council in the life of the Church in Australia," said Archbishop Timothy Costelloe SDB.

The bishops also approved the process of implementation of the Plenary Council. Plenary Council vice-president Bishop Shane Mackinlay said the work of implementation – the Council's third and final stage – will be critical.

AUDIO VISUAL UPDATE

A few years ago, we upgraded our sound system and now we need to upgrade the visual component. It has been obvious for some time that we needed to find a better way of projecting words and images for our masses and other services. The Parish Finance Committee has approved the process by which we purchase LED screens so that we can future proof this important aspect of our worship.
