Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today's Gospel (Jn 11:1-45), is the third reading we have had from John's Gospel this Lent. Like the others it is a sophisticated and fascinating piece of literature. Don't just look for a 'moral'. John's Gospel abundantly repays quiet meditation and reflection.

Jesus' raising of Lazarus is the climax of his public life in the Fourth Gospel. It is the last straw for the religious authorities who begin to plot to arrest Jesus and bring about his death. When Jesus hears of the illness of his friend Lazarus, aware of the risk, he leaves the 'safe place' (east of the Jordan river) and enters Judea to give life to his friend. In taking this risk he seals his fate.

When Jesus arrives at Bethany both Martha and Mary remonstrate with him: 'if you had been here my brother would not have died'. Jesus engages in an important dialogue with Martha. Jesus presses her on her faith in the resurrection and then her faith in him. He reveals his identity and mission in a striking way: 'I am the resurrection and the life, if anyone believes in me, even though they die they will live.' He asks her if she believes this. Martha's answer is the profession of faith in John's Gospel (the other Gospels give this task to Peter) "I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, the one who has come into this world'. It is worth underlining that this profession of faith is given to a woman.

Each one of us is the friend 'whom Jesus loved'. Like Martha and Mary we can honestly share our feelings with our friend. In conversation with Jesus we, too, can profess our personal and shared faith and hope in him. Our brother or sister in need is the one for whom he left his "safe place' in order to raise them from death. To us, too, he promises that 'even if we die we will live'.

As we hear or read the Passion in the ceremonies of Holy Week, especially Good Friday, the Furth Gospel invites us to pray: 'It is for love of me and all people that Jesus gave his life to rescue us from death and bring us to eternal life.' - Greg

Stay to give thanks together as a community as we rejoice in our renewed friendship and new life with God.


