Dear brothers and sisters,

To paraphrase H G Nelson: in the Palm Sunday liturgy 'too much Scripture is barely enough'. I will therefor confine myself to brief reflections on the readings from Matthew's Gospel which we hear today. Jesus' entry into Jerusalem on a donkey does not meet any conventional expectations of the Messiah. He is humble, compassionate and brings healing, peace and hope not wealth, prestige or victory in war.

In the garden when the authorities come to arrest Jesus, one of his companions resists violently, cutting off the ear of the High Priest's slave (26:51). Jesus rebukes him. He is always non-violent. He goes to his suffering and death with a freedom that comes from his sense of his divine mission of self-sacrificing love. All that will happen is gathered up and overcome by an overwhelming act of love. Matthew gives us a hint of love's victory as the earthquake and opening of tombs foreshadows the resurrection (27:50-54).

In the ancient world, the killing of an innocent person was a monstrous crime. The guilt for which was not only carried by the perpetrator but also by their family and community. Matthew portrays the arrest and execution of Jesus as the shedding of the blood of the most innocent person there has been. So, who is guilty? Well, first off, Judas, who attempts to atone by giving back the money he received to betray Jesus. The priests won't touch it, as it is blood money. So, Judas despairs. He fails to believe that forgiveness and reconciliation is what Jesus brings, even to people like him.

Next, Pilate, warned by his wife to have nothing to do with 'that innocent man' (27:19), washes his hands before the crowd, saying 'I am innocent of this man's blood' (27:24), which of course he is not. Finally, the people as a whole answer, 'His blood be upon us and upon our children' (27:25). Sadly, this verse in isolation has been used to support anti-Semitism. The responsibility for the death of Jesus does not continue on in the Jewish people as a whole. The Australian Catholic Bishops have produced WALKING TOGETHER an excellent statement on the Catholic-Jewish relationship, calling for our renewed dialogue and cooperation on many fronts.
