Dear brothers and sisters,

The **First Reading** (Acts 1:1-11; see also Luke 24:46-53) signals that Jesus was crucified on the claim that he was a political Messiah, and therefor, a rebel against Rome. But it was this Jesus that God raised from the dead. He has now entered glory at God's right hand. While he has gone from human sight, he has commenced to reign in heaven. This does not mean an abandonment of either the disciples or his saving mission in the world. On the contrary, he is present and active in a new mode of being through the power of the Spirit.

The disciples had felt the power of the Spirit that was upon him during his earthly life. Now they are assured that, because of his messianic enthronement, the Spirit will come upon them and accompany them as they take his word and witness 'to the ends of the earth'.

Today's **Second Reading** (Eph 1:17-23) portrays the raising of Christ from the dead and his enthronement at God's right hand as one continuous exercise of divine power. It is a triumph over all the powers hostile to God's plan for human beings and for the cosmos as a whole. Christ has been placed 'above' all these powers in a way that involves their subjugation. The 'salvific program' has yet to run its course. Hostile forces still abound, but Jesus' Paschal victory has dealt them a fatal blow. We are marked by hope that all that dehumanises, all death and violence in our world do not have the last word.

In today's **Gospel** (Matt (28:16-20), the risen Lord sends out his disciples on mission to all the nations of the world. We are firstly called to make disciples. Then to baptise, and to instruct how to respond in faith into the communion of love that is the Triune God. Today's Preface reminds us of our hope: The Lord Jesus, the King of glory, conqueror of sin and death, ascended to the highest heavens, as the Angels gazed in wonder. Mediator between God and man, judge of the world and Lord of hosts, he ascended not to distance himself from our lowly state but that we, his members, might be confident of following where he, our Head and Founder, has gone before. Therefore, overcome with paschal joy, every land, every people exults in your praise.—**Blessings, Greg**


