Dear brothers and sisters,

On Pentecost Sunday we celebrate the Lord's gift of the Spirit to the Church at its beginning and up to today. The Spirit is the divine life and energy of the Church. Pentecost is not a past event but is ongoing.

In today's **First Reading** (Acts 2:1-11) people from many regions who hear the testimony of the apostles in their own languages. It is a reversal of the Tower of Babel where people could not understand each other due to language differences. The Church will speak in many languages but communicate through each the same essential message concerning the outreach of God's compassionate love. The empowering Spirit, which rested solely upon Jesus during his own life, has now been given to those who carry on his mission 'to the ends of the earth' (Acts 1:8b).

In the **Gospel** (Jn 20:19-23) the gift of the Spirit is linked with the resurrection and exaltation of the Lord. So it is on the evening of 'the first day of the week' (i.e., Easter Sunday) that Jesus appears to the disciples, makes clear his identity, and imparts to them the 'Peace' that overcomes their fear. The risen Lord breathes the Spirit upon the disciples (reminiscent of God breathing life on Creation in Genesis) giving them and through them the church the mission to reconcile all people in God's name.

In the **Second Reading** (1 Cor 12:3-7, 12-13) Paul rejoices in the varied gifts of the Spirit which build up the Church. Using the image of our bodies he shows how a variety of gifts collaborate within a fundamental and dynamic unity created by the Spirit. Every gift of an individual, a people or a culture manifests the Spirit bestowed for the benefit of the entire body.

Today Pope Francis tells us in Fratelli Tutti it is time to appreciate the "blessed awareness that we are all part of one another" and can "no longer think in terms of 'them' and 'those,' but only 'us.' " Infant Jesus parish has received a precious gift from the Holy Spirit in the wonderful, friendly spirit that marks our whole community. We are people from many nations and cultures united around the altar, nourished by the Lord's word and sacraments. Each one of us has the precious gift from God of his Holy Spirit so that we can contribute to the life and effectiveness of our families, parish and community.

Today, we celebrate the wonderful diversity of the Spirits manifestations in our parish. Please consider how you can be part of the ministries of our Church that we may be evermore the Church that the Lord wants for our time and into the future.—*Blessings, Greg*
