Dear brothers and sisters,

The First Reading (Ex 34:4-6, 8-9) has Moses dealing with God following Israel's idolatry with the Golden Calf (Exod 32). Will Israel regain its privileged status as the Lord's special people? Before Moses gets around to pleading with God for forgiveness and forbearance, he hears God's proclamation of who he is: 'The Lord, the Lord, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness' (v. 6). So, the God of the Old Testament is not a God of wrath and vengeance but the God of love and compassion.

In the Gospel of John, the actions, the words and the very personality of Jesus reflect the reality of God. There is an identity between Christ and God. In today's Gospel (Jn 3:16-18) God's mission to the world is not condemnation but to rescue us from bondage to sin and death and to draw all people into the communion of life and love which is God's very being. This is the great work of the Son. God's compassionate love is always shown in action.

The Second Reading (2Cor 13:11-13) consists of the concluding grace from Paul's Second Letter to the Corinthians prefaced by an exhortation to unity and peace in the community. Our life together should reflect the dynamic life of God through our equality, diversity and mutuality. The word 'grace' (Greek charis) basically refers to the gift in a person that renders her or him attractive. To pray that the 'grace of the Lord Jesus Christ' be with a community is to ask that each and every believer be captured by this presence of Christ. Secondly, there is the hope that we come to know God (the Father) primarily as a God of love. Thirdly, the grace of the Holy Spirit common to all who believe in Christ is the foundation of our community/communion. Belief in God as Trinity is then an invitation to a saving relationship.

While a fully developed theology of the Trinity took over 400 years of prayer and reflection on Christian experience, we find that Paul, in the earliest days, refers to God as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The inner life of the Trinity is a dance of love marked by equality, difference, and mutuality. Our holiness is sharing that dynamic life of the Trinity.

The feast of the Holy Trinity calls us to contemplate and celebrate God's self-revelation in Christ, through the Spirit, as loving and deeply involved with humanity. It is a reminder of our values, identity and mission.
