Dear brothers and sisters,

Today's **First Reading** (2 Kings 4:8-11, 13-16) and **the Gospel** (Matt 10:37-42) share a focus on hospitality and welcome. The Shunamite woman who welcomed and gave hospitality to the prophet Elisha foreshadows the promise contained in the Gospel for those who 'welcome a prophet because he is a prophet.' Hospitality in the desert was and can be today a matter of life and death. It was and is sacred.

The woman's gift of hospitality offered out of respect for the man of God brings a reward within a year: 'you will hold a son in your arms.' In the Gospel, a simple gift of a cup of cold water will not go unnoticed by God. In the beginning of the Gospel Matthew, Jesus is "God with us", 'Emmanuel". The climax of this theme is at the end of the Gospel in the parable of the Great Judgement where with its refrain: 'As often as you did this to one of the least of my brothers and sisters you did it to me.' Host and guest, benefactor and the one in need are united as family.

Jesus warns that 'anyone who prefers father or mother to me is not worthy of me.' This reflects an early time of persecution in the Church. Where some members of a family were Christian, and some were not, there was a stark choice between 'preferring' mother or father and allegiance to Christ. The problem for us today is to actually hear the challenge of discipleship and not to dismiss it as extremist or impossible. The words of Christ, however, apply to all believers now and always. If we are simply comfortable in our world, sharing its consumerist values and aspirations, then we avoid vital aspects of Christ's message.
