Dear Parishioners,

For the second part of my bulletin series (don't worry there will only be four in total, unless Fr Greg has a change of heart), I thought I would give you some idea of what a priest does in a day. In fact, many people, including members of my own family, have asked me: "What do you priests do in a day?"

The answer, of course, varies depending on the day; however, we Carmelite priests have our days structured around communal prayer and meals. The community starts each day reciting Lauds (morning prayer) and celebrating mass, then, in the evening, praying Vespers (evening prayer). Also, as Carmelites, we are required to do an hour of mental prayer in the morning and in the evening, as well as recite midday prayer, Complines, and the Office of Readings.

As much as possible we have lunch together as a way of fraternally sharing our life and experiences of the day with each other. In between prayer and meals, you will find one of us attending a meeting (there are many of these!), performing a house blessing, giving spiritual direction, anointing the sick and dying, hearing confession, reflecting on the Scriptures, writing the next homily, or preparing members of the faithful for an upcoming funeral/wedding (just to name a few).

What I have personally found to be key to priestly ministry is the ability and willingness to be present to people in all their needs. Many come to us priests to discuss spiritual and every-day matters; we encounter people from all walks of life, who come seeking some comfort, guidance, and care. And usually these people, not always our parishioners, come at a point when they are most vulnerable. Whilst this is a most privilege space to occupy and provide for people, it can be very taxing, mentally, spiritually, and even physically. In all this, our role as priests is to bring the love of Christ to others, and this we can only do if we ourselves are firmly grounded in Jesus through the vivifying presence of the Holy Spirit.

I hope this has given you some idea of what we do as priests, and I would encourage you to get in touch with one of us, either directly or via the parish office, if you would like to talk about any matter that may be weighing in your heart. As always, I thank you all for your ongoing support and care for us Carmelites. Know, also, that many of you have taught me so much about how incredibly powerful God in the lives of His faithful. Together, let us pray for more vocations to the religious life (especially the Carmelites) and to the priesthood.
