Dear Parishioners,

With Fr Greg due to return late next week it will mean two things (at least). Firstly, you will have another piece from me (the current edition you have in your hands), and secondly, you will have another article next week (I thought I was only due to write four in total, but it would seem that I will have an opportunity to write a fifth; think of it as an "encore" piece, if I could be so bold). In fact, it has been most encouraging receiving honest feedback from many parishioners. As I have often said, "Come to Morley if you want to learn the ropes of being a priest: you will be run off your feet just as much as you will be supported and encouraged."

As you may recall, last week I spoke of the great resource that is the "Catechism of the Catholic Church". In many ways it distills the great tradition of over 2,000 years history of the Catholic Faith in one resource; making it an indispensable reference for grounding one firmly in the Faith. As to be expected, the Catechism serves as a foundation for a life-long learning process. A good tip is to pay particular attention to the "footnotes" provided, if you would like to know more about a particular teaching. Among the many great sources cited, the greatest is of course, the Bible.

Many, seeking to better engage and pray with Scriptures have asked me for resources. The Diocese of Broken Bay have compiled a delightful compendium of accessible biblical resources (see the link below). I suggest clicking on "Bible Study" and looking at "The Bible in a Year Podcast", which was ranked the number one podcast program on the Apple Podcast platform (beating other popular and secular shows such as The New York Times). This podcast is also produced by Ascension Press and is lead by Fr Mike Schmitz; a very worthwhile podcast indeed.

Also, I have been running a bible study session on Thursdays (6.30-8pm) at the parish centre. The first half-hour is a time spent in relative darkness and quiet, where participants sit in silence, reflecting on the week that has been. Afterwards, the group prays with and discusses the upcoming Gospel for the Sunday. In these sessions, I encourage everyone to ask as many questions as they wish (even seemingly controversial ones - no question is off limits). Ultimately, my great hope for those who come is that they would have already engaged with the Bible to help them better participate in the Mass. Indeed, as experience shows, the more we know the Bible, the more we will encounter Jesus Christ, alive and active in our lives, through the workings of the Holy Spirit.
