Dear brothers and sisters,

The First Reading and the Gospel today highlight the unlimited generosity of God. The First Reading (Is 55:6-9) prepares us for the Gospel with its insistence upon the gulf between God's ways and human ways. We are invited to abandon all our evil ways and turn to God. The parable in the Gospel (Matt 20:1-16) breaks with our conventional expectations. The vineyard owner's generosity to the day labourers seems unfair. But he gives each a day's wage no matter how long or short they worked. A day's wage was just enough to support and feed a family. We are all recipients of God's boundless generosity. These actions of God move us to open ourselves to the Spirit and to be open-hearted and open handed in our dealings with the poor and suffering of our world.

The referendum on the Voice to Parliament has become an ugly political stoush even to the extent of the Russian Government working for the No option. Here is the official Catholic advice:

"Australia's Catholic bishops have encouraged Catholics to read and discuss the Uluru Statement from the Heart the document from which the Voice proposal emerged. This could be a significant step towards a more just and equitable Australia. We want to encourage all Australians to educate themselves as well as possible concerning the proposal to establish the Voice. This is an important moment in the history of the nation, and it can help us to move towards a deep and just reconciliation. It also offers a mechanism to improve the lives of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples."

SYNOD ON SYNODALITY

The Synod Process in which we have participated moves to a new phase with the first world assembly in Rome this October. We should continue to pray for the success of the Synod. The second assembly of the Synod will take place during October 2024.
