Dear sisters and brothers,


The **First Reading** for the First Sunday of Advent this year (Is 63:16-17; 64:1, 3-8) expresses a longing for the salvation that is yet to be fully accomplished. God who is responsible for Israel's very being is like a potter who can refashion the clay when needed, so God can refashion Israel's fortunes (cf. Jer 18:1-6).

The **Second Reading** (1Cor, 1:3-9) describes the time of 'waiting' for the Lord's coming. The Spirit is active assuring believers of God's abiding love which is creative in the variety of gifts that build up the community and equip it for mission (1 Cor 12-14). Despite his physical absence, we who believe enjoy 'communion' with the risen Lord. This communion presently may involve sharing Christ's sufferings, but as God is faithful, it will ultimately become a sharing of his glory beyond our imagining (cf. Rom 8:17).

The **Gospel,** (Mk 13:33-37) features an extended image: a householder who goes on his travels instructs his servants but especially the one charged to watch the door to stay awake and be watchful. The master expects to be welcomed whenever he returns. Everyone else may sleep but this servant watching the door must stay awake at night, always on the lookout for the master's coming. We are called to be 'gatekeepers' alert for the coming of the Lord. The rest of the world may 'sleep' but we are 'children of light and of the day' (1 Thess 5:5), our lives illuminated by the risen Lord and enriched by the hope of his final coming.

In Advent we pray that we may be prepared to joyfully meet Christ, our Lord, whenever and however he comes so that we may be share eternal life with him and all the saints.
