Dear sisters and brothers,

We have begun the season of Lent where the readings follow a similar pattern each year. So, I thought I might focus more on the liturgy. We offer mass for the intentions of the Church and particularly for those of us who gather to celebrate the Eucharist. At the beginning of Mass the priest invites everyone to pray: "Let us pray" and is then silent. This silence is for everyone to speak to God about their needs and prayer intentions. The priest then 'collects' all these intentions in the opening prayer which is called the 'Collect'. Today I will begin some reflections on the Collect of the mass each Sunday. I will base my reflections on the scholarly work of Gerard Moore (brother of Fr Michael Moore, SM).

Here is Gerard's translation from the Latin of today's Collect: "Grant, almighty God, through the yearly observances of holy Lent, that we may grow in understanding of the riches hidden in Christ and by worthy conduct pursue their effects. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever." This prayer has been used for the First Sunday of Lent since the Sixth Century. It establishes a framework for pursuing the discipline of Lent. The aim of all our Lenten observances is growth in being able to stand under the paschal mystery, becoming more receptive to the riches wrought by Christ. Growth in understanding is necessarily complemented by right action. Our worthy conduct brings out the effects of the riches hidden in Christ. These are acts of building the reign of God by our growth in love.

These themes are echoed in today's Gospel (Mk 1:12-15): Jesus has emerged from his baptism clad with the Spirit, the power of God's love (1:11). The Spirit then 'drives' him into the wilderness, the habitat of wild animals as well as evil spirits. Jesus' connects deeply with the best and worst of humanity and experiences God profoundly. He takes time apart, a retreat or a sabbath, to allow God to touch and re-form his imagination and prepare him for his ministry and the offering of his life for us.

Rather than just giving something up for Lent, we might commit to taking time to see ourselves and our world through God's eyes. This way of praying moves us beyond our current horizons, renews our faith and moves us to action in the Spirit first given us in the waters of Baptism.—Blessings, Greg


St Mary's Cathedral - Voluntary Ministry Open Day THIS Tuesday 20 February 10.30am
