Dear sisters and brothers,

As we are now more than halfway through Lent the Collect of today's mass invites us to rejoice: O God, who through your Word reconcile the human race to yourself in a wonderful way, grant that with prompt devotion and eager faith the Christian people may hasten toward the solemn celebrations to come. The prayer stresses wonder at the heart of our faith in a loving God. We ask the grace to respond well to God's initiative as we hasten eagerly towards our celebration of the saving mysteries of Holy Week and Easter. This prayer was crafted for the new Roman Missal after Vatican II. However, it's heart is ancient: a petition from Pope Leo the Great (died 461) was grafted onto an invocation from an ancient Roman Lenten prayer.

The **First Reading** (2 Chron 36:14-16, 19-23) heartens us that salvation and restoration, rather than punishment, will be God's last word.

In the **Second Reading** (Eph 2:4-10) Paul stresses the extravagance of God's love and generosity. All the nations are included in the riches of salvation. This world-embracing salvation is entirely the undeserved gift of God. We are God's work of art' (Greek poiêma [whence 'poem' in English]). We are God's poem in progress. We are not junk to be either hammered into shape or discarded as useless.

The glorious climax of John's Gospel is the victory of Jesus lifted up on the Cross for the salvation of all. In today's **Gospel** (Jn 3:14-21) Jesus is talking with Nicodemus and explains to him God's wonderful purpose: 'God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not be lost but may have eternal life. For God sent his Son into the world not to condemn the world, but so that through him the world might be saved' (3:16-17). God's whole intent is to save and communicate eternal life through the outpouring of love that the cross represents.

Judgment is not so much something that will happen in the future. It is something that we undergo when we honestly expose our lives to the saving light that Christ brings into the world (3:18-21). It is to this joyful 'judgment' that Lent invites us. The eternal life Jesus promises begins in this life and reaches its fullness in our definitive encounter with God. God created us, not to control us or condemn us but to bring us into communion with God. Remember and be grateful: 'Rejoice, again I say rejoice!'—*Blessings, Greg*

PALM SUNDAY






For the past few years, the church has not supplied palms for you take home on Palm Sunday. Again, this year you are encouraged to cut a branch for yourself; olive tree,

LETTER-BOX DROP FOR EASTER




