Dear sisters and brothers,

With the Second Sunday of Easter, we conclude the Octave of Easter. Today's Collect guides us: "God of everlasting mercy, who in the very recurrence of the paschal feast kindle the faith of the people you have made your own, increase, we pray, the grace you have bestowed, that all may grasp and rightly understand in what font they have been washed, by whose Spirit they have been reborn, by whose Blood they have been redeemed." We pray for an increase of faith so to appreciate God's grace given us in Baptism. We have been washed clean from sin in the water of the font, reborn in the Spirit and redeemed by the blood of Christ.

This prayer is addressed to God the Father as the "God of everlasting mercy". To me this everlasting mercy recalls the motto of St Teresa of Ávila: "I will sing forever the mercies of God" and St Therese of Lisieux's 'Offering to Merciful Love'. The joy of Teresa and the trusting hope of Therese are grounded in the mercy of God. The popular devotion to the Divine Mercy is a Christological interpretation of the merciful heart of God. St John Paul II, Popes Benedict and Francis have made mercy the source of Catholic prayer and pastoral care.

Our Gospel (Jn 20: 19-31) presents doubting Thomas who becomes the first to proclaim the risen Lord as 'My Lord and My God'. Maeve Louise Heaney suggests that: "When we doubt things, when we put things in question, it can be a really helpful space for us to grow and to know more. We are lifelong learners... Doubt (can be) understood as the humility implicit in knowing that we do not know everything and that while revelation in Christ is complete, our understanding is not."

IMPORTANT CHANGES TO NOTE

Due to the unexpected demand for niches in our columbarium, the committee, with approval of Fr. Greg, have updated the Columbarium General Conditions with regard to who may apply for a niche and who may be interred in the columbarium.



These new conditions will take effect from MONDAY 29TH APRIL, 2024.

After this date, those who may apply for a niche are:

- A current or former parishioner who wishes to apply on behalf of a spouse or partner or dependent child who is deceased.
- A current or former parishioner aged 65 years or older who wishes to reserve a niche in advance for themselves, their spouse or partner; and/or
- A current or former parishioner who is terminally ill and wishes to reserve a niche in advance for themself.

Similarly, after this date, those whose ashes may be interred in the columbarium are:

- ♦ A current parishioner or a former parishioner approved by the committee;
- ♦ A current or former parishioner and their spouse or partner; and/or
- ♦ A parishioner's dependent child, including a child by adoption or who is a member of the parishioner's step-family, or other non-dependent children as approved by the committee.

Any applications prior to 29th April, 2024, will be covered by the current General Conditions. If you have any concerns or queries regarding these changes, please contact the Columbarium Committee at columbarium@infantjesusparish.org.au.

If you would like to make an appointment to submit an application or discuss the changes to the General Conditions, please phone the parish office on 9276 8500 and one of the committee will be in touch. Also, a member of the committee is always available on Monday between 9.30am and 11.00am.
