

Dear Parishioners

It was a great joy to me, at the Easter Vigil Mass, to baptise four new Catholics into the faith, and to Confirm four others, completing their initiation into the Church. Each year, the Vigil Mass is the culmination of a long journey, as the RCIA team and catechumens meet almost weekly over many, many months and come to know each other at a deep level.

The RCIA programme is designed to be led by Catholics who slowly introduce the teachings of the Catholic church to non-Catholics. It is not a journey to be rushed! It is a wonderful time of exploring the faith for ourselves and revealing the truths that we find there to those who have come to seek the truth.

Soon, on **Tuesday 27th May at 7pm**, we will have our enquiry night for the next RCIA journey, hopefully culminating in more new Catholics being baptised at Easter 2015. We already have quite a list of people who have expressed interest in being baptised into the Church, or completing their initiation with the Sacrament of Confirmation. If you know of anyone who may be interested, please encourage them to come along.

There never seems to be a shortage of people curious about our faith, but sadly it is not so easy to find the willing Catholics to walk the journey with them. We really do need more of you to join us on the team, to help share the load and also, importantly, to share your faith story and insights with us – because that is the greatest witness of all. You do not need to be a theologian to be part of the team - just a person of faith and commitment. Please speak to me if you wish to know more.

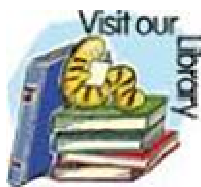
