

Dear brothers and sisters,

Today's *Gospel* (Lk 9:51-62) is the turning point of the Gospel of Luke: Jesus 'sets his face to go to Jerusalem' - to his betrayal and death. Jesus is sent by the Father to endure the pain of the world so as to heal it. On the way a Samaritan village is inhospitable to the messengers that Jesus sends before him. James and John want a violent response: let's call down fire from heaven to destroy the village. But Jesus is not violent. Soon, he will confront murderous inhospitality in Jerusalem. But again, he rejects violence (cf. 22:35-38, 49-51). Jesus brings peace not violence (19:41-44). Jesus' passion is to rescue people and set them free in a world heading for destruction. In the face of such urgency even the most sacred family obligations give way. We are called, then, to a costly discipleship.

Dietrich Bonhoeffer, the German Lutheran theologian executed by the Nazis wrote that our salvation is not a cheap grace but the costly grace won by Jesus' death on the cross. "Cheap grace is the grace we bestow on ourselves. Cheap grace is the preaching of forgiveness without repentance, baptism without church discipline, Communion without confession.... Cheap grace is grace without discipleship, grace without the cross, grace without Jesus Christ, living and incarnate." (The Cost of Discipleship)

In line with this, in the *First Reading* (1Kgs 19: 16, 19-21) Elisha breaks up his plough and slaughters his oxen demonstrating a radical break with his old life and a total commitment to the life of a prophet. In the *Second Reading* (Gal 5:1, 13-18) Paul calls his readers to live out the costly freedom that Christ has won for us by allowing the Spirit to create in us the love of Christ.


