During the week I met with the Acolytes for an evening of reflection on this important ministry. As part of our discussion, we talked about the need for Acolytes, as instituted Ministers, to learn all they can about their faith, especially in relation to the celebration of our liturgies.

In today's Gospel, we hear how important it is to always carry the Word of God with us and to obey Jesus' teachings. In carrying out our Christian mission, whether it be as instituted Ministers, volunteers, congregants, parents, spouses, children, friends or carers, we need to remember this important message. We do not need degrees or special talents, bigger houses, better schools or clothes; we need only to carry with us everyday Christ's Word for us and to live out that Word. Only then we will be truly successful and be able to praise God with great joy.
