

Dear brothers and sisters,

Today's Gospel (Jn 15:1-8) is a beautiful extended image of Christ as the 'true vine'. It is an important element of John's theology of divine intimacy with us and how God dwells in us and we in God (divine indwelling). The image of the vineyard has roots in the Old Testament where Israel is the 'vine' God brought out of Egypt and 'cultivated' in a new land (Ps 80: 8-11).

Christ is the 'true vine,' and we, his disciples, share his divine life and vitality so that we can bear 'fruit'. The Father is the vineyard owner and vinedresser. God cuts away branches that yield no fruit while fruit-bearing ones are pruned. What enables a branch to yield abundant fruit is the vigour of its union with the vine. Hence the need for believers to maintain a loving union with Christ. The 'fruitfulness' of that union is acts of love that flow from the love we have received from union with Christ sharing the sap of life which is his gift of the Spirit.

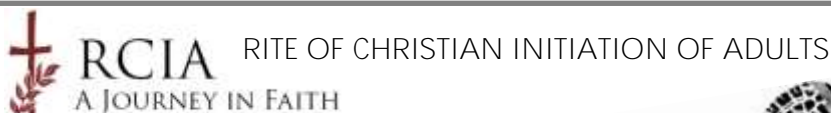
How are believers 'pruned already' by Christ's word? The whole revelation of God in Christ (his birth, his life with Mary and Joseph, his proclamation of the reign of God, his healing and liberating ministry, his death and resurrection) is what 'prunes' us. This 'word' which reveals the heart of God also includes 'coming to the truth' of ourselves, bringing the darkness of our lives before the healing and transforming light of God (see John 3:19-21; 4:23-24).

Believers are truly his disciples when their lives are transformed and energised by the fruitful love manifested in Jesus. This is the 'glory' of the Father in Jesus and in his saints, among whom we are included, revealing to the world that God is love.

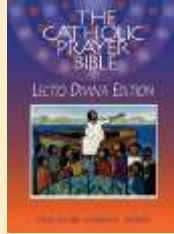

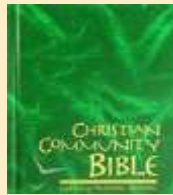
